Bonjour Paris Travelers!

This email contains important information for Paris travelers. We know it's long, but please read it carefully and to the end.

I hope your holiday season is going well!

Payments

By now you should have paid your deposit along with the September, October, and November payments (\$1450). Chaperones should have paid \$1050, and shadow travelers should have paid \$1350. If you are not current on your payments, or have not made pre-approved arrangements with us I will be contacting you individually to discuss the feasibility of the trip.

There isn't a payment due for December. The next payment is due January 15th.

The trip will be here before we know it – watch for monthly updates as we get closer to our departure!

Passport Copies

We've only received about a third of the passport copies needed. Please send these in right away. We must have your passport numbers to be able to book the flights. Chaperones, Shadows, and Staff – we need copies of your passports as well. One set of copies will be with the head chaperones while we travel, the other set will stay here in Mukilteo. Once the trip is over, all passport copies will be shredded.

If you do not have a current passport, it needs to be ordered immediately. The latest reports have passports taking 4-6 weeks for processing.

Roommate Request

Students, we need to know your roommate requests for the trip. Each hotel room will have two single beds. **Please email me with your first and second choice for a roommate, or put it on a piece of paper and put the paper in the band forms box in the band room.**
