About Show Band

Kamiak Show Band is comprised of wind, percussion and color guard members from Kamiak High School.

Acceptance into Show Band is a competitive process where members audition for spots. Rookie tryouts take place in the spring of the school year before they would enter Show Band. Students with successful auditions are notified by the director and invited to a rookie meeting before the end of the school year.

Show Band activities benefit our kids in many



ways. Freshman rookies make new friends before they transition into high school. Members gain new life skills

and independence through travel. Show Band students are academic achievers, athletes, mentors and leaders of tomorrow. Band members work hard as a team and take pride in a job well earned and well done.

Show Band clinicians and staff work with the band members to teach the music and field show. They also give positive feedback, and support our students in revising and improving the show throughout the season.

How much time does Show Band take?

Pre-season - before school starts

- Rookie meeting at Kamiak High School in the spring after auditions
- Get full Show Band schedule in spring.
- Section practices during the summer – scheduled by section leaders
- Rookie camp with all uniforms fitted, at Kamiak, 2 days mid-August prior to camp
- Band Camp is at Kamiak this year, two weeks, mid-August

Competition season- fall, during school

- Practice two evenings a week during show band season
- One or two Saturday practices and a parade
- Parent night & BBQ night w/show preview
- Game and half time performances at all Kamiak home football games
- Four weekend competitions, two local and two travel with some overnights

Post season - spring optional

- Perform in a parade or two during the spring, can be overnight trip
- Domestic or international performance trip every third year

How much does Show Band cost ?

Approximate 2010 prices

- \$375 covers band camp expenses, buses to each competition, show staff fees & overnight housing.
- \$25 annual band uniform usage fee
- \$7 annual band uniform cleaning fee
- \$4 gloves*/ \$15 Garment bag*
- \$35 band shoes*/ \$14 plume*
- \$7 Tux clean may be required
- \$40 color guard sneakers
- \$60 color guard gloves, makeup, etc.

Student accounts will be charged these fees

Financial aide available. *initial & replacement cost.

Does not include:

- Food on day or overnight trips to competitions** or
- Individual Student spending money.

**breakfasts may be provided on overnights

Optional post season band trip expenses including

- Victoria up to \$300 2nights & bus
- Domestic extended trip price 2009. Approx. \$1,600-\$2,200.
